

DIRECTING A SHORT FILM ABOUT EARLY ADULTS WHO ARE EXPERIENCING A QUARTER LIFE CRISIS PHASE TITLED “BREATHE”

PENYUTRADARAAN FILM PENDEK TENTANG DEWASA AWAL YANG MENGALAMI FASE QUARTER LIFE CRISIS BERJUDUL “BREATHE”

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Abstrak : *Quarter life crisis* merupakan sebuah krisis yang dialami dewasa awal di rentang usia 21-30. Krisis ini disebabkan oleh banyak faktor yaitu, finansial, karir, keluarga, romansa, dll. Masalah ini timbul karena ketidaksiapan para individu di fase transisi ini karena kurangnya pengalaman untuk mengatasinya, jadi seringkali para dewasa awal merasa *stuck* dan *overthinking*. Oleh karena itu, penulis memiliki ide untuk membuat film pendek sebagai media utama dalam menyampaikan dan memberikan sebuah pandangan dalam mengatasi krisis *quarter life* ini dengan cara bernapas yang bisa dikatakan sepele. Bernapas bukan sekadar proses berlangsungnya kehidupan, namun juga bisa untuk mengontrol diri.

Abstract : *Quarter life crisis* is a crisis that experienced by early adults in the age range of 21-30. This crisis is caused by many factors, namely, financial, career, family, romance, etc. This problem occurred due to the unpreparedness of individuals in this transitional phase due to a lack of experience, so early adults often feel stuck and overthinking. Therefore, the writer has the idea to make a short film as the main media in conveying and providing an outlook on overcoming this quarter life crisis in a way that can be said to be trivial. Breathing is not just an ongoing process of life, but also for self-control.

INTRODUCTION

According to Yale Medicine, 70% of early adults have experienced quarter life crisis. Mostly it affected to millennials 86% according to *Satu Person*. Quarter life crisis is a transition phase from adolescence to adulthood period where early adults usually find new obstacles in their life with lack of preparedness. In this phase, quarter life crisis gives them impacts psychologically and emotionally which make them feel stuck, unstable, overthinking (Aristawati et al., 2021). Overthinking often occurs in quarter life crisis which can make individuals lose their natural rhythm due to their thoughts lead them to create a false reality rather than act naturally (Petric, 2018). When early adults couldn't handle the situation no more, they will be stress. Stress is associated to people who can't control their breath properly when they are in pressure. In this state people will feel overwhelmed, anxious or even worse depressed (Koolhaas et al., 2011). In managing stress, people have to control their breath properly because when people are stressed, they often use short breathing technique. Besides the process of in and out of oxygen and carbon dioxide, breathing can make people calm and improves emotional control (Broderick & Metz, 2009).

From this phenomenon, the writer has decided to make a short film in a way to convey messages about how important breathing is in quarter life crisis phase. Based on IDN Times people love to watch relatable movies to the real life 37,2% and moral value 27,1% from 411 respondents. Film or video is one of the best ways in order to spread messages because it contains visual and audio that can influence people's mind 94% possibility according to Dwyer (Fadlika W.R, Kusuma Dewi C, Fiandra Y et al., 2022).

RESEARCH METHOD

In order to support the idea that came up with, the writer used several research methods to collect the data through observation, interview, questionnaire, similar artworks, and literature studies:

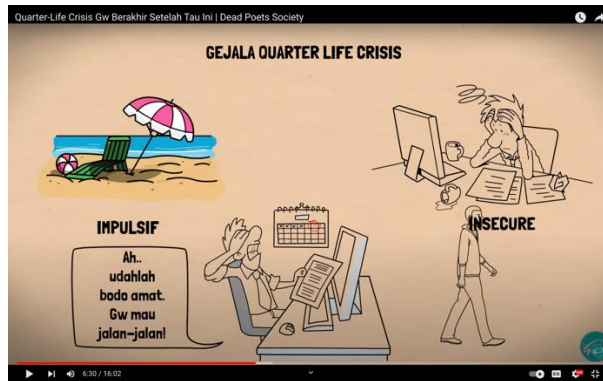


Figure 2.1 Quarter Life Crisis Symptoms

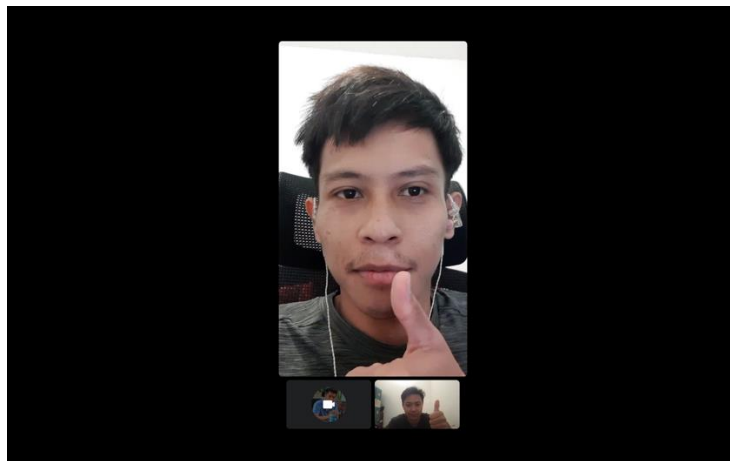


Figure 2.5 Interview Haldy Koesoema

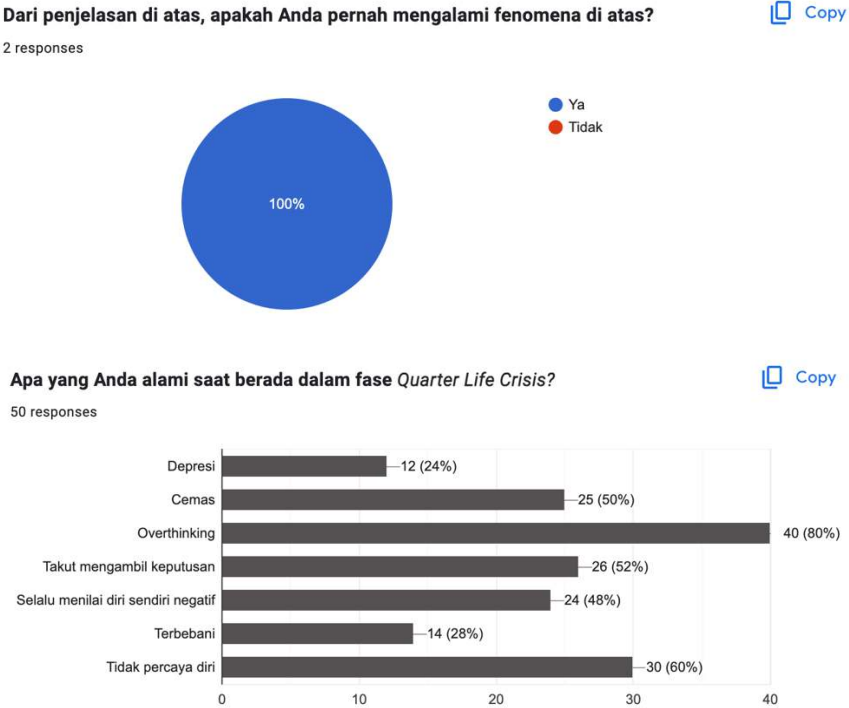


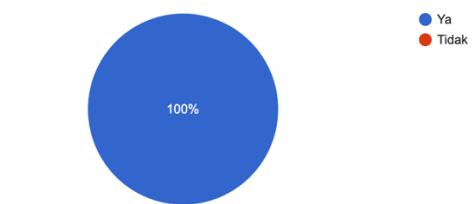
Figure 2.6 Questionnaire Charts

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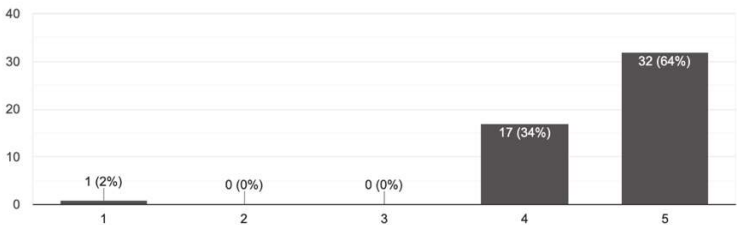

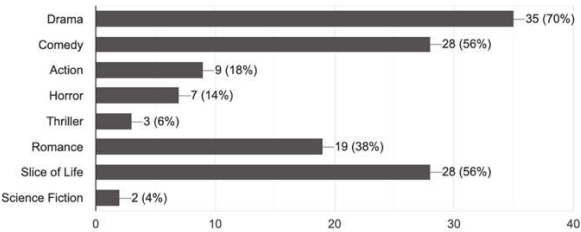


Figure 2.7 Questionnaire Charts

Literature Studies

Quarter Life Crisis

Quarter-life crisis is a condition where a person enters a period where they have to adapt to new situations such as starting to learn to be responsible and find their identity. People in this phase are usually trapped internally and externally (Aristawati et al., 2021).

Regarding to message concept of this final project, it can be concluded from the analysis result that has been obtained, all of the respondents would like to be represented by “Breathe” short film. The message is to give an overview about how to face quarter life crisis by breathing that can be considered as the simple thing, but the key is how the writer makes the simple thing looks fundamental.

The directing concept that will be used is by using daily basis approach in order to be related to early adult’s problem in metropolitan city, especially Bandung. It is going to be a slice of life. The language style is also using daily basis language from its cultural aspects. It is intended to put aside the boundaries between film and audiences.

This short film has 4 phases such as, fall, rise, victory, and breathe. Every phase will tell the story about the main character’s life in accordance to the title of the phase.

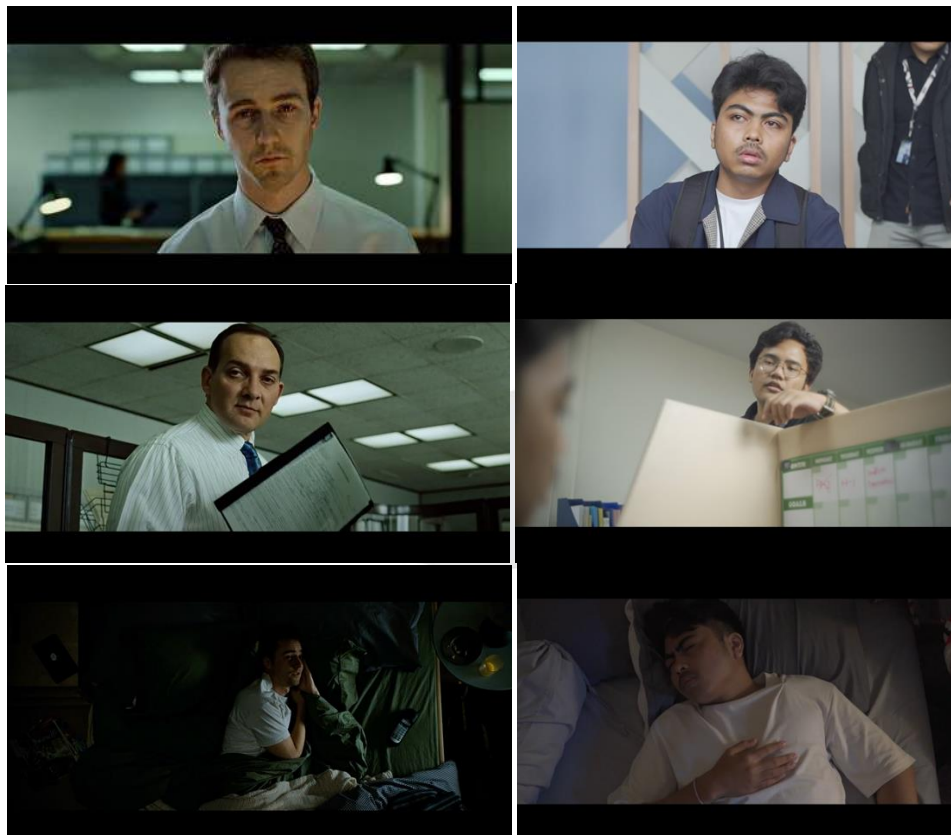


Figure 3.3 Scene Comparisons from Fight Club

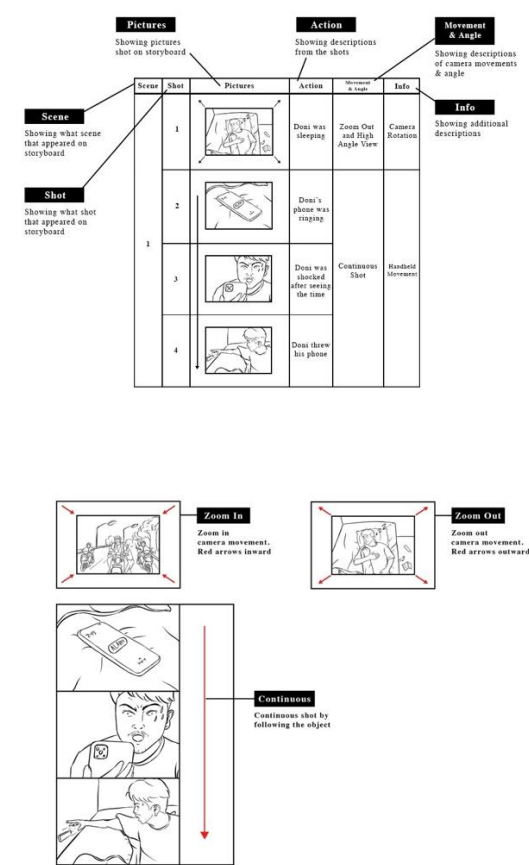


Figure 3.4 Breathe Storyboard

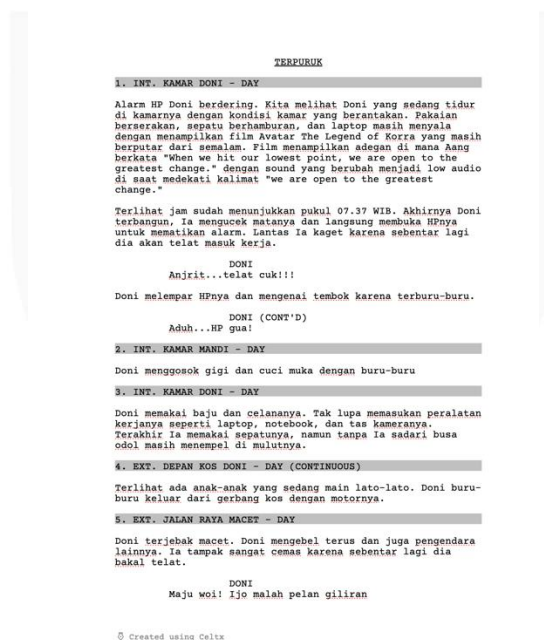


Figure 3.7 Breathe Script
